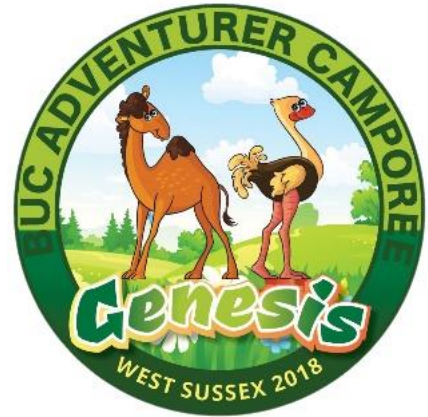


Adventurer Bible Experience (ABE)

Sample questions – Genesis 1-6

Here is a sample of questions to practice with your Adventurers ahead of the ABE Testing at Adventurer Camporee, so they will have an idea and be familiar with the question format.



The best way for Adventurers to become familiar with the texts is to read through the chapters, explore the story and get to know the facts, names of places, the people, their ages, what God said at certain times, and how the story in the chapter developed. The more they read the story, the more they will be able to recall and answer.

We suggest studying and reading through all chapters as a group then assigning specific portions to individual Adventurers. The Bible version used for the questions will be the NKJV which is the same as the Pathfinder Bible. Most clubs who take part in the PBE will already have these Bibles.

Many Adventurers have a very retentive memory and whilst it is not wholly necessary to completely memorise all the texts, without noticing, they will learn good portions of the chapters.

Parents should be encouraged to study together with their children and draw lessons of encouragement as a family from each chapter.

Instructions, rules and timings for Camporee ABE will be sent out shortly. However please note the following:

- Participants should be Adventurer-age children only.
- The ABE Testing will take place during Sabbath School time which commences at 9:00am; those participating are required to be in class A dress uniform.
- Teams can be made up of up to 6 Adventurers with 1 alternate who can swap in after the half time break.
- The testing will be done in two halves of 10 minutes each, with a 5-minute break in between.
- Results and Presentations for ABE will take place during the Sabbath evening program.
