The year 2018 has proved to be a very special year for the work of the Welsh Mission Youth and Pathfinders departments: and – greater still – it isn't over yet! Talking about problems and issues would be unfair: the blessings outnumbered them greatly.

We started the year without Pastors Jeremy Tremeer and Jovan Adamovic for the first time in almost 10 years. They have jointly led the department, and their experience and creativity were greatly missed. However, with Pastors Adriana Fodor and David Rancic taking over the Youth department, Pastors Jeremy Tremeer and Emanuel Bran also had opportunities to serve the Welsh Mission youth and experience the joys and blessings of the youth work first-hand.

As usual, Welsh Mission events represented a great opportunity for our young people to meet, serve and organise activities, getting valuable experience in the work of our Mission. Global Youth Day is becoming an important event for our Mission. Several years ago, we made a decision to focus our attention to help our smaller churches to become better known in their communities. This year, we visited Carmarthen for the Global Youth Day in March. Not only that, but we visited the same town again later in May for the 'Global Youth Day – Revisited' to participate in some of the activities we hadn't been able to fit in the first time. We visited the local children's hospital ward, bringing toys and spending some time with the children and their parents. We washed cars for the firefighters' charity, gave out some literature, sang at the nursing home, and offered free hugs, flowers, and hot cross buns (in March, just before Easter), raising awareness about the true meaning of Easter.

Another major date in our calendar is the 3 Missions Easter Weekend, which took place in Northern Ireland this year. We had a group of 30 people who attended this event and made some great memories as a result. Also, the Welsh Mission Young Adults' Retreat is becoming another major event for our youth. It normally takes place in October and represents a weekend for our young people to involve themselves in prayer, socialising, and deeper discussions about faith issues.

Similarly, talking about the Welsh Mission Pathfinders department, one cannot but be pleased with the development of this ministry in the Welsh Mission. For years, Newport was the only club in the Welsh Mission. Then, the Cardiff and Ammanford clubs were established in the last 1-2 years. We will remember 2018 for the addition of the Telford Ghana Pathfinder club to our Pathfinder family.

The main event this year was the BUC Adventurer Camporee, in which the Welsh Mission Adventurers also took part. However, we had our own Pathfinder Camp held at one of our favourite campsites – Islwyn Scout Camp, near Newbridge in South Wales. Probably the most exciting experience for our Pathfinders and Adventurers was taking part for the first time in the Pathfinder Bible Experience. The Welsh Mission winner was the Cardiff club, with Newport coming in second. They represented the Mission at the BUC PBE at Newbold College back in March. Interestingly, the Welsh Mission now has a trophy that will be passed to each winning team at Mission level in the years to come.

It's worth mentioning that the local leaders recognised greater parent involvement in club activities, day-to-day running of the clubs, and even the renewal of enthusiasm to assist in those who were Master Guides already but not yet involved in their clubs. This is very pleasing and exciting news for such a small Mission as ours. It serves as an inspiration to other parents, youth and children to get involved and join their local clubs or found new ones.

However, the highlights of the year in both Welsh Mission Youth and Pathfinder departments are baptisms. Seeing our young people come through the ranks and make decisions to get baptised through the work of Pathfinder and Youth leaders is so wonderful, exciting and rewarding, and it is encouraging to know that parents, churches, pastors and leaders are doing a job that the youth recognise and consider it worthwhile to identify with the values of our churches across the Mission. Finally, it behoves us to continue with the work we have done so far and be more responsible and intentional in working with our young people and Pathfinders.

I would especially like to mention Toochi Chigbo, Christine Keay, Gareth Courtney, and James and Ellen George, who were baptised this year and inspired some other youth to think about their relationships with Christ and their own baptisms.

I would like to use this opportunity to express my gratitude, in the first place, to Pastor Dejan Stojkovic and Natalie Davison from the BUC Youth department for their support and help. The same goes to the BUC and the WM treasurer Earl Ramharacksingh and his team, who provided the financial backing for many activities and events that took place in both departments. Thirdly, to Pastor Emanuel Bran, the WM president, for showing a willingness and interest to be involved with the work of the two departments and giving a hand when needed. Next, to my friend and co-sponsor, Pastor Adriana Fodor, for the great work she has done with the youth this year. Also, to local youth leaders and Pathfinder Club directors and Master Guides, to local churches and parents – without you, nothing mentioned above would have been possible. You are the real power behind everything we have done together, and it is a very special privilege to serve you and alongside you. Further, to all Welsh Mission Youth and Pathfinders, who, with their joy, respect, faith and love, are helping us as leaders to continue our work for you. Finally, to God, for His provisions, love, mercy and inspiration to keep on serving in the years to come.

For years we have had Pathfinder camporees, and everyone loves attending them, but we realised that maybe we owe the opportunity to experience this amazing experience to our Adventurers as well: so, for the very first time ever in the British Union Conference we organised our first BUC Adventurer camporee.

The previous Union Youth Ministries director, Pastor Nathan Stickland, realised that because of the GYLC event happening in Kassel, Germany, this summer, the Division Pathfinder Camporee was deferred by a year, and summer 2018 presented itself as the time when we could run this event. Subsequently, it became my privilege to plan this event for our Adventurers.

The theme of Genesis was apt because we wanted to begin the sequence the year before the TED Pathfinder Exodus Camporee took place, but also, significantly, because it was the first all-Union Adventurer Camporee ever organised.

The team responsible for planning this event originated from all over the British Isles – from North and South England, Scotland and Wales; we also gathered a team who would be able to serve not only for the Genesis Camporee but the Exodus one as well. We had anticipated 1,000 people attending, but, when the camp opened, over 2,000 people arrived to attend this Adventurer Camporee, including two international groups from Sweden and from Slovenia. We want to say thank you to volunteer staff and attendees for making this camporee even more special because you came.

The camp took place on one of the hottest summers in the UK on record. For the first time ever, the British people were not able to complain about their poor weather, but in fact some were now complaining about the heat and lack of rain! And we also heard tell that there was not one single cube of ice for sale within a 20-mile radius of the campsite! It highlights the importance of being prepared for all seasons – even in England!

The whole experience was amazing – we had great worships with Richard Aguilera, who was our speaker each day, and he really engaged the children with his fascinating talks. The final Sabbath was another highlight because we had our inaugural Adventurer Bible Experience (ABE), in which every club attending had been invited to take part. What we didn't know was how much the Adventurers were looking forward to this part of the programme and how hard they had studied in their clubs. Of course, after it was over, the question they all asked was: 'When is the next ABE taking place?' Consequently, we have now included ABE in our annual calendar of events, and we know that next year even more Adventurers will be registering to participate. It was a blessed way for these young children to study the first six chapters of the book of Genesis, and next year they are working hard on Luke chapters 1-12.

Now that the BUC Adventurer Camporee is behind us, what I remember most are the smiles, the excitement and how apparent it was that the Adventurers wanted to be at the camp and nowhere else.

The Trans-European Pathfinder Camporee is taking place at the South of England Showground, West Sussex, England from 30 July to 6 August 2019. It will be our pleasure and joy to welcome you here as our guests!

We love you, and see you in 2019!



The year 2018 has been non-stop with activities for the Pathfinders. The year 2019 is already lining up to be a packed one for the Pathfinders and Adventurers, with Adventurer Camporee, TED Pathfinder Camporee (UK) and Oshkosh International Camporee (USA) in their advanced planning stages. The training programme dates are in place and we have plans to increase drilling & marching and drum training to include more training days throughout the year to meet the demand! Be careful – if you blink your eyes you might miss something! I want to encourage all young people of Pathfinder age to come and see what Pathfinders has to offer: you may be pleasantly surprised! Finally, I want to recognise the area co-ordinators, club leaders and staff who for the love of this ministry volunteer themselves, their time and their resources to help make this ministry as God intended.






Over the last year the Youth Ministries department has taken a strategic approach to understanding the landscape of youth ministries in the SEC. We have worked rigorously behind the scenes in creating a whole new strategy to meet the needs reflected in our recent 50\*7 project. The qualitative and quantitative research revealed that there is an identity crisis within the Adventist Church, especially among young adults. A lack of relevant biblical literacy, along with a lack of loving and accepting church environments, has led in some cases to the haemorrhaging of young adults from the church. Generally, young adults do not understand the relevance of their Adventist Christian experience within the postmodern/post-Christian context, and they are unable to authentically worship in the current church context. This causes a strong sense of dissonance and they are no longer able to identify with the church.

It has been well documented that if the church wanted to keep its young adults, its leader need to be authentic, honest and transparent. The organisation also needs to be transparent and accountable. The new YM strategy has the potential to create a subculture of authenticity, which will allow the church to become a relevant part of a young person's life.
