How Jesus has saved us



Step 1: God is love



The Lord appeared to us in the past, saying:

"I have loved you with an everlasting love;

I have drawn you with unfailing kindness. Jeremiah 31:3

Step 2: I am a sinner



<u>What is sin?</u> Everyone who sins breaks the law; in fact, sin is **lawlessness**.

If anyone, then, knows the good they ought to do and doesn't do it, it is sin for them.

Who is a sinner? For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Step 3: God sent Jesus to die. But why?



For the **wages of sin is death**, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 6:23

For God so **loved the world** that He gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

...if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9
